02 Numbers of Admitted Students and Eligibility Requirements

A. Numbers of Admitted Students: Master's Degree Program – 44 students, Doctorate Program (Integrated Master's and Doctoral degree) – 26 students

B. Eligibility Requirements

- 1) International students whose parents are both foreign nationals, are overseas Korean citizens, or international students who have completed courses equivalent to elementary, middle, secondary and university education in Korea are eligible to apply. All Applicants must meet the following requirements. (However, applicants to the Department of Nursing must hold a valid nursing license)

Master's Degree Program / Integrated Master's and Doctoral Degree Program	Doctorate Program
Applicants who have completed or are expected to complete a bachelor's degree, or those who are recognized to have the equivalent degree or higher. (Applicants who are planning to receive their bachelor's degree must acquire it before the date of admission)	Those who have, or are expected to complete a master's degree, or those who are recognized to have the equivalent degree or higher. (Applicants who are planning to receive their master's degree must acquire it before the date of admission)

- ※ Applicants for master's degree programs can apply to any department regardless of their undergraduate major. However, applicants for the Doctorate Degree Programs in certain departments (especially those with integrated programs must meet specific academic or major requirements. Refer to Appendix 3 for details.

2) Language Proficiency Requirements for both Master's and Doctorate Programs

- A) Applicants must meet **at least one** of the following language proficiency requirements, either in Korean or English:

- ※ Note: English native speakers or students from countries where English is used as a common language may be exempt from the English test score requirement. (However, for citizens of countries where English is an official language, only those who have completed an English-based curriculum will be recognized)

04 Application Documents

- Applicants must submit original documents or notarized copies.
- All documents should be in Korean or English. Documents in other languages should be accompanied by a notarized Korean or English translation.
- It is recommended to prepare extra documents for visa issuance in advance since submitted documents will not be returned.

05 Screening Method & Scoring

A. Screening Method: Special Selection

- Interview(Interviews will be conducted)

※ If, for unavoidable reasons, such as delayed visa issuance, an applicant living abroad is unable to attend an interview, it may be acceptable to hold a virtual interview after verification of identification.

In such cases, evidence, such as a certificate of non-entry of Korea, must be submitted.

○ Screening Methods for Each Category

- The suitability of the applicant's submitted documents will be reviewed
- During the interview, *learning competency*, *knowledge of major*, *research plans*, *academic attitude* and *ability to express oneself* will be assessed.
- For preparation of interview for the Department of Fine Arts, refer to <Note 3>. Applications must be submitted to the department office 3 days before the interview.

C. Selection of Applicants and Disqualification from the Process

- 1) The number of applicants admitted is determined by each department/disciplinary program. If two applicants have the same score, and only one can be chosen, criteria for the selection are as following:
 - ① The applicant who has a higher score in academic competency related to their major.
 - ② The applicant who has a higher score in academic attitude and communication ability.
 - ※ The number of applicants admitted will be allocated according to the proportion of support per recruitment unit if the number of applicants exceeds the admission quota.
- 2) In the following situations, applications will be considered incomplete, and applicants will be disqualified. There may be additional grounds for disqualification based on the selection policies as determined by MNU's Graduate School Admission Committee.
 - ① Applicants who fail to attend the required interview
 - ② Applicants who score less than 40% in the interview
 - ③ Applicants who submit documents containing false information (including typing errors).
 - ④ Applicants who fail the document screening process, including those who submit incomplete documentation.- ※ Applicants who submit an expected certificate of graduation must submit a certificate of graduation and educational background certificate before the start of this semester. Failure to do so will result in admission being revoked.

- Failure to pay tuition during the tuition payment period will result in cancellation of acceptance
- Pass will be canceled if payment is not registered due to unidentified details of the announcement
- Admitted applicants whose tuition bill is paid as "0" must submit the tuition bill to the bank designated by our school for registration

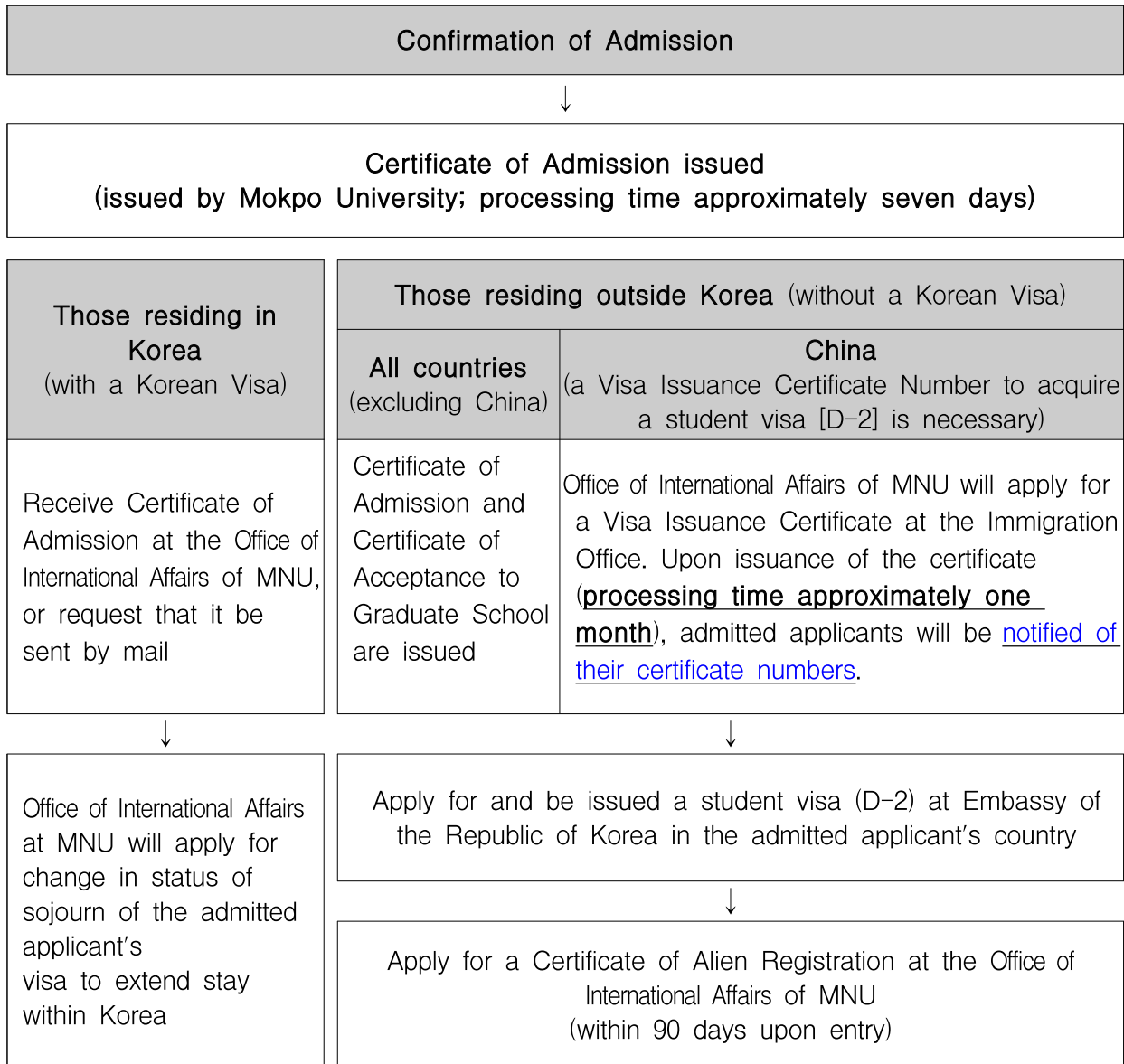

08 Reminders for Applicants

- 1) Applicants must fill in every required field correctly. Applicants are responsible for any disadvantages arising from typing errors, missing documents, etc. Any falsification or misrepresentation in application documents will result in the application being immediately revoked even if the applicant would have otherwise been accepted.
- 2) Since it is not possible to modify or cancel the application form after the application for admission is completed, it is necessary to be aware of the recruitment guidelines and check the information entered before the application is received.
- 3) Applicants can apply for only one department and cannot change the department that they apply for after the documents are accepted.
- 4) Once an application is received, it is assumed that the applicant agrees to their personal information being used for admission purposes. The personal information of applicants will not be used or offered for any purpose other than admission.
- 5) All received documents and application fees will not be returned. If an applicant is unable to finish the admission process for unavoidable reasons such as natural disaster, diseases, accidents, etc., the application fee minus a service fee will be returned.
- 6) If it becomes known that an applicant is ineligible or has falsified information (grades, forged and/or falsified documents, substitute exam-takers, etc.), acceptance or admission will be canceled.
- 7) Admitted applicants must register during the registration period. If not, they are considered to have no intention to enroll in graduate school, and will be treated as a waiver of registration.
- 8) Admission will be cancelled if the applicant is found to be a non-graduate as a result of an academic background inquiry. In this case, the registration fee will be refunded in accordance with the refund policy of the university.
- 9) Applicants should provide correct and current contact information during the period of admission selection. The Graduate School of MNU is not responsible for any results arising from incorrect contact information.
